Board and Commission Openings that Require Senate Confirmation

Geological Survey Board - (1) vacancy - 4-year terms

Political split requirements allow applications from both parties.

(1) Qualified electors of the state who possess the knowledge, experience and skill to qualify them for the position.

Mental Health Professions Licensing Board – (1) unexpired term - 4-year terms

Members must be residents of the state for a minimum of one year.

(1) Public member

Occupational Health and Safety Commission - (1) unexpired term

(1) Representing business or industry

Board and Commission Openings that DO NOT Require Senate Confirmation

Board of Cosmetology - (1) vacancy occurring 1/1/10 - 3-year terms

No member of the board shall be affiliated with or hold interest in any cosmetology school while serving as a member of the board.

(1) Licensed cosmetologist who is a Wyoming resident with at least five years of experience immediately preceding appointment.

Early Intervention Council - (2) vacancies - 3-year terms

(1) Representing parents

(1) Representing service providers

Emergency Response Commission - (3) vacancies

(1) Representing the tribal council

(1) Representing local government

(1) Representing private industry

The Department of Family Services Advisory Council - 3-year terms

Legislation allows for not more than 14 members to represent the public and the department.

Ground Water Advisory Committees - (1) unexpired terms and (4) vacancies – 6 year terms.

(1) Representing Water Division I

(1) Representing Water Division II

(3) Representing Water Division IV

Health Benefits Plan Committee – (1) unexpired term and (4) vacancies occurring 7/15/09 - 4-year terms

(1) Representing an authorized insurer writing individual and group health insurance business in Wyoming

(1) Healthcare provider

(1) A licensed insurance agent experienced in selling health insurance

(1) A licensed physician who specializes in pediatric care or family medicine

(1) A member of the general public

Board of Hearing Aid Specialists - (1) unexpired term - 4-year terms

(1) Certified otolaryngologist

Independent Living Council - (5) vacancy occurring 1/1/10 - 3-year terms

The majority of the membership will need to consist of persons with disabilities. Custom application blanks meeting federal requirements are needed and can be acquired through the contact. Land Quality Advisory Board - (1) vacancy - 4-year terms

Political split requirements allow applications from democrats or independents.

Mental Health Planning Council - (4) vacancies - 3-year terms

The Council shall be made up of residents of the state and include in its membership representatives of the principal state agencies involved in mental health, higher education training facilities, and public and private entities concerned with the need, planning, operation, funding, and use of mental health and related services and activities, including consumers. At least one half of the membership shall consist of individuals who are not state employees or providers of mental health services.

Board of Nursing Home Administrators - (1) vacancy - 4-year terms

- (1) A registered nurse who is not employed by a nursing home

Board of Occupational Therapy - (1) vacancy - 3-year terms

- (1) A member of the public with an interest in the rights of the consumers of health services

Board of Physical Therapy - (3) vacancies occurring 9/30/09 - 3 year terms

A medical doctor shall be appointed from a list of five medical doctors, recommended by the Wyoming Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association. Those recommended shall be practicing physicians who have practiced in Wyoming for at least five years immediately preceding appointment. The physical therapist member shall be appointed from a list of five qualified physical therapists submitted by the Wyoming Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association. Applicants shall meet all requirements established by the Association and shall have practiced a minimum of three years in Wyoming.

Wyoming Public Television Council – (1) vacancy occurring 6/30/09 - 4-year terms

- (1) A member representing the public at large

Board of Examiners of Speech Pathology and Audiology - (2) vacancies occurring 1/1/10 - 3-year terms

Members shall have been residents of this state for at least one year immediately preceding their appointment and shall have been engaged in rendering services to the public, teaching or research in speech pathology or audiology for at least five years immediately preceding the appointment. All board members except the consumer and physician, surgeon or dentist shall at all times be holders of active and valid licenses for the practice of speech pathology or audiology in this state.

- (1) A speech pathologist
- (1) A licensed physician, surgeon or dentist

Trails Council - (1) vacancy occurring 12/1/09 - 4-year terms

Members shall provide equal representation of motorized, non-motorized, historic and recreational trail users in Wyoming.

- (1) Representative of an equestrian (non-motorized) recreational trail user

Volunteer Firemen's Pension Fund Board - (1) unexpired term

Appointments shall be made from nominees recommended to the governor by the Wyoming State Firemen's Association.

- (1) Volunteer firemen with a minimum of five years service as members of volunteer fire departments in the state of Wyoming.

Wheat Marketing Commission - (2) vacancies - 3-year terms

Geographic representation of membership on the commission shall be provided for based on historical wheat production records.

Council on Women's Issues - (2) unexpired terms

Membership will be made up of at least one appointee per judicial district (1-9). Political split requirements allow applications from all parties.
