Board and Commission Openings that Require Senate Confirmation

Board of Agriculture – 2 unexpired terms

One (1) member shall be appointed from each of the four (4) board of agriculture youth leadership quadrants.

The northeast quadrant shall consist of Campbell, Crook, Johnson, Niobrara, Sheridan and Weston counties; the northwest quadrant shall consist of Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park, Teton and Washakie counties.

(1) Registered barber who is a Wyoming resident and holder of a valid registration certification that has been renewed for the period of not less than five years immediately preceding the appointment and shall not be either directly or indirectly connected with any barber school or college.

Wyoming Business Council Board of Directors - 5 vacancies occurring 3/1/12 - 3-year terms

All of the appointed directors shall be appointed at large and at least twelve shall be residents of Wyoming

Wyoming Community Development Authority - 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

Not more than four shall be from the same political party. There are currently (2) Republicans and (2) Democrats (not including the 3 members who will term on 3/1/2012) seated on the Authority.

Wyoming Cultural Trust Fund Board - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

(1) The administrator of the division of cultural resources or his designee

Board of Dental Examiners - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

(1) Representing dental hygienists - Selection is made from a list of candidates provided by the Wyoming Dental Hygienists Association.

Board of Education - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 6-year terms

Political split requirements allow applications from both parties.

(Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park and Washakie counties comprise district 5)

Energy Resources Council - 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

- (1) Member shall represent to the greatest extent practicable the diverse components of Wyoming's energy industries
- (1) Member shall represent to the greatest extent practicable the diverse components of Wyoming's energy industries
- (1) Member shall represent to the greatest extent practicable the diverse components of Wyoming's energy industries

Enhanced and Improved Oil Recovery Commission - 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3 year terms

- (1) Public at large with experience in oil and gas industry;
- (1) Member of oil and gas commission
- (1) Representative of oil and gas industry;

Environmental Quality Council - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

No employee of the state, other than employees of institutions of higher education, shall be a member of the Council. Political split requirements apply.

Geological Survey Board - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

Political split requirements apply.

(1) Qualified elector of the state who possesses the knowledge, experience and skill to qualify them for the position.

Infrastructure Authority – 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 4 year terms

A majority of persons appointed shall be qualified voters of the state. Members shall have special knowledge, as evidenced by college degrees or courses, or with at least five years experience in managerial positions in the field of electric transmission or generation development, or natural gas or coal production, transportation, marketing or industrial or municipal consumption.

Board of Insurance Agents Examiners - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 5-year terms

At least five of the insurance agents on the board shall be licensed in Wyoming for at least three years immediately prior to appointment.

(1) A life agent.

Commission of Judicial Conduct and Ethics - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

(2) Electors of the state, who are not active or retired judges, or attorneys.

Board of Medicine - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

(2) Physicians licensed to practice medicine in Wyoming

Mental Health Professions Licensing Board - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

Any vacancy on the board shall be filled by the governor from a list of eligible candidates from that affiliated discipline whose position is vacant. Members must be residents of the state for a minimum of one year. Board members representing the professional disciplines shall have at least four years of experience in the discipline.

(2) Licensed mental health professionals:

(1) Marriage/family therapist

(1) Addiction therapist

Mining Council - 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

Members shall be qualified electors of the state with at least five years experience in the mining industry immediately preceding appointment. Members shall be appointed equally from among the management and hourly employees of the mining industry.

(2) Representing management employees

(1) Representing hourly employees

Oil and Gas Conservation Commission - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 2-year terms

(1) Representing the public at large.

Board of Outfitters and Professional Guides - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

Political split requirements apply.

(1) Public at-large member who is not employed by and does not receive any income or compensation from outfitters or professional guides.

(1) Licensed outfitter or guide with not less than five years of experience in outfitting or professional guiding in Wyoming (This representative must come from District 7; Natrona, Fremont and Converse counties comprise district 7.)

Selection is made from a list of nominees from the licensed outfitters in Wyoming. Two nominees shall be submitted for each board vacancy and appointments shall rotate among game and fish commission appointment districts.

Parks and Cultural Resources Commission - 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 5-year terms

Political split requirements apply.

- (1) Representing appointment district 5: Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park, and Washakie counties
- (1) Representing appointment district 7: Converse, Fremont, and Natrona counties
- (1) Public at large

Board of Parole - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 6-year terms

Political Split requirements apply.

Wyoming Pipeline Authority - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 4-year terms

(2) Qualified voters of the state with special knowledge, as evidenced by college degrees or courses, or with at least five years of experience in managerial positions, in the field of natural gas production, transportation, marketing or industrial consumption.

Board of Psychology - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 5-year terms

Each member who is a psychologist shall be licensed under this act and shall have a minimum of three (3) years of post-licensure experience.

- (1) Member who is a psychologist and is engaged full time in the doctoral teaching and training of psychologists

Real Estate Commission - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

No more than one commissioner shall be appointed from the same county. Teton, Washakie, and Converse counties are currently represented on the Commission.

Telecommunications Council - 9 vacancies - 4-year terms

Members shall have demonstrated an interest and involvement with telecommunications issues through participation in business, public and postsecondary education, government, libraries or other entities involved in the dissemination or receipt of information and shall reflect the diverse needs of telecommunications in Wyoming.

- (9) Representing the public at large

Wyoming Tourism Board - 2 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 -3-year terms

Wildlife and Natural Resource Trust Account Board – 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

Membership will be made up of at least one appointee per judicial district (1-9). Political split requirements apply. Membership shall reflect experience in wildlife, agriculture, energy, sportsmen and tourism.

- (1) Judicial District 6 - Campbell, Crook, and Weston counties
- (1) Judicial District 7 - Natrona County

Board and Commission Openings that DO NOT Require Senate Confirmation

Animal Euthanasia Technician Certification Board – 4 vacancies – 3 year terms

Members shall be certified euthanasia technicians, licensed veterinarians or certified peace officers appointed by the governor.

Child Care Certification Board - 7 vacancies occurring 2/18/2012 - 2-year terms

- (4) Lay members who are residents of the state and operators of child caring facilities or parents.
- (3) Not more than four additional lay members with an interest in child care.

Board of Chiropractic Examiners - 1 vacancy occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

- (1) A practicing chiropractor who shall have practiced chiropractic continuously in Wyoming for at least three years and have a diploma from a recognized chiropractic school or college.

Board of Cosmetology - 3 vacancies occurring 1/2/2012 - 3-year terms

No member of the board shall be affiliated with or hold interest in any cosmetology school while serving as a member of the board.

- (2) Licensed cosmetologist who is a Wyoming resident with at least five years of experience immediately preceding appointment.
- (1) Licensed cosmetologist who is also an instructor with at least five years of experience immediately preceding appointment.

Wyoming Council for Interstate Adult Offender Supervision – 3 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 – 2-year terms

- (1) Representative of victims groups
- (2) Members from the executive branch

Governor’s Domestic Violence Elimination Council - 19 vacancies - 3-year terms

Members represent victim advocates, survivors, law enforcement and local and state governmental agencies and judicial systems.

(3) Licensed embalmers who are Wyoming residents and shall each have had at least 3 years of experience in the practice of embalming and disposition of the dead human body, and who shall each have had 2 years previous to their appointment an unexpired embalming license.

Wyoming GIS (Geographic Information Systems) Coordination Oversight Committee – 2 vacancies occurring 1/1/2012 – 2-year terms

Health Benefits Plan Committee – 2 vacancies - 2-year terms

- (1) A parent

Impaired Driving Council – 18 vacancies - 2-year terms

The Council shall include both government and private sector members, who may include representatives from the following entities appointed by the Governor: Department of Transportation (Highway Safety Office, Public Affairs, Support Services), Department of Health (Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services Division, Chemical Testing Laboratory), Department of Revenue (Liquor Division), Department of Family Services, Wyoming Judiciary, Office of the Attorney General, Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police, Wyoming Highway Patrol, Wyoming County and Prosecuting Attorney Association, State Public Defenders Office, Victim Services Division, Safe Communities, Prevention Advocates, Private/Public Substance Abuse Treatment Providers, Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission, County Coroners, Local Government, and the Governor's Office.

Independent Living Council - 2 vacancies - 3-year terms

Innovative Education – 2 vacancies - 1 year term

Judicial Nominating Commission - 2 vacancies occurring 2/28/2012 - 4-year terms

No member of the commission excepting the chairman shall hold any federal, state or county public office or any political party office, and after serving a full term he shall not be eligible for re-election or reappointment to succeed himself on the commission. No member of the Commission shall be eligible

for appointment to any judicial office while he is a member of the commission nor for a period of one year after the expiration of his term for which he was appointed.

(1) An elector of the state not admitted to practice law.

Cannot be from Judicial Districts 1, 4, 5, 7, or 8 as no more than two members can be from the same judicial district.

Mental Health Planning Council - 7 vacancies occurring 3/1/2012 - 3-year terms

The Council shall be made up of residents of the state and include in its membership representatives of the principal state agencies involved in mental health, higher education training facilities, and public and private entities concerned with the need, planning, operation, funding, and use of mental health and related services and activities, including consumers. At least one half of the membership shall consist of individuals who are not state employees or providers of mental health services.

Non-Point Source Task Force - 5 vacancies occurring 3/31/12 and 1 unexpired term - 4-year terms

This applicant shall have had at least two years of experience in an **administrative or teaching position in a nursing education program**.

Board of Examiners of Speech Pathology and Audiology - 2 vacancies occurring 12/31/2011 - 3-year terms

Members shall have been residents of this state for at least one year immediately preceding their appointment and shall have been engaged in rendering services to the public, teaching or research in speech pathology or audiology for at least five years immediately preceding the appointment. All board members except the consumer and physician, surgeon or dentist shall at all times be holders of active and valid licenses for the practice of speech pathology or audiology in this state.

Governor's Substance Abuse and Violent Crime Advisory Board - 18 vacancies - 3-year terms

Membership consists of individuals who represent community advocate and volunteer organizations, law enforcement, corrections, the National Guard, the courts (including judges, prosecuting, and defense counsel), educators, members of the Legislature, local government, the public, medical services, youth services organizations, the treatment, prevention, and recovering community, tribal interests, the business sector, the faith community and the U.S. Attorney for the State of Wyoming. Additional members recommended by the Directors of various other state departments may also be appointed.

Telecommunications Relay System Advisory Committee - 2 vacancies - 3-year terms

Political split and district requirements apply.

- (1) Representing appointment District 3; Lincoln, Sublette, Teton, or Uinta counties
- (1) Representing appointment District 6; Crook, Niobrara, or Weston counties

Trails Council - 2 vacancies - 4-year terms

Members shall provide equal representation of motorized, non-motorized, historic and recreational trail users in Wyoming.

Workers' Compensation Medical Commission - 7 vacancies occurring 12/31/2011 - 3-year terms

The Commission is comprised of licensed physicians appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the Wyoming Medical Society and health care providers appointed from a list of nominees developed and submitted by appropriate health care provider groups selected by the director. The governor may appoint no more than eleven (11) additional health care providers as associate members of the commission whose function is limited to serving as members of individual medical hearing panels.
